## Frequently Asked Questions

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### Q · Are my results confidential?

Yes. Completely. Results are never shared with your GP, partner, or anyone else without your explicit written consent. Your privacy is protected at every stage.

### Q · How soon after exposure should I test?

Most bacterial STIs: 10–14 days after exposure. HIV: most accurate at 28 days, though early detection tests are available from day 10. Our team will advise on the best timing.

### Q · What happens if my result is positive?

Our clinical team will contact you directly, in a calm and supportive way, and advise on your options, treatment, and next steps.

### Q · I have no symptoms. Should I still test?

Yes. Many STIs — including chlamydia and HIV — can be completely asymptomatic for months or even years. Regular testing is the only reliable way to know your status.
